The annual report has been filed with the Employees Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Insurance Information

The plan has contracts with various insurance providers for life, disability and health claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2017 were \$401,551.

You have the right to receive a copy of the full annual report, or any part thereof, on request. The items listed below are included in the report:

1. an accountant's report;
2. financial information and information on payments to service providers;
3. assets held for investment; and,
4. information regarding any common or collective trusts, pooled separate accounts, master trusts or 103-12 investment entities in which the plan participates.

You also have the legally protected right to examine the annual report at the main office of the plan (BorgWarner Inc., 3850 Hamlin Road, Auburn Hills, MI. 48326) and at the U.S. Department of Labor in Washington, D.C., or to obtain a copy from the U.S. Department of Labor upon payment of copying costs.
